Hello and welcome to worship!

We are looking at and around the cross today. The cruel criminal that repented who was nailed to a cross beside Jesus, has always amazed me. I have always wondered what it was about Jesus, that caused the criminal to repent. The other criminal observed the same Jesus. He heard the same mouth speak "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do." but, no change. Was it Jesus' look of love from the cross? Was it His forgiveness of others? Death has a way of making you rethink things. Maybe he rethought things as he thought about his death. Everyone around Jesus is mocking him and even this criminal had mocked Jesus at first, but what changed? Only a short time earlier this man is mocking Jesus with the same unrepentant heart and now in a moment of time he is a changed man. I don't know exactly why, but the cross is that powerful. Why is it not Peter at the cross speaking on behalf of Jesus and God? Why is it not one of the other apostles speaking on behalf of Jesus and God? When it looks as if most have turned their backs on the Savior, a thief is the one who turns toward the Savior. That amazes me and I hope it does you. Listen to the repentant thief's words from the cross. "Do you not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation? And we indeed justly, for we are receiving the due reward for our deeds; but this man has done nothing wrong." And he said, "Jesus remember me when you come into your kingdom." The cross has the power to change. Have you allowed it to change you?
