Hello and welcome to worship!

Listen to 1 Timothy 3:15, "if I delay, you may know how one ought to behave in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the truth." There is so much in this verse for the church to get excited about and to lift the spirits of those in the church. First, we notice that the Holy Spirit calls the church the household of God. Notice the family talk here. We are in the family of God. I grew up with a great family and when I think of my family it brings great memories. The family of God is a blessed description of what we ought to be. Notice also with the words "household of God" where God dwells. He dwells within the church. This is His household. This is the temple not made with hands. His house is not built with stones made by hands, but by spiritual stones of men and women. Secondly, the Holy Spirit reveals to us that the church is the church of the living God. Our God is living and active and He actively lives in the church. This is a living temple that God dwells in. Thirdly, notice also the strength found in the church from the one who dwells in her. We are the pillar and buttress of the truth. Oh, I hear strength in those words. This word buttress means support. Here we are in all of God's strength holding up the truth for the world to see. When the enemy attacks with false teachings, the church in the Lord's strength, stands supporting the truth. The more we learn about what God thinks of His church, the more excited we will be in His church.
