He was the first President of the Tecumseh Roundup Club. If you had anything to do with horses around Tecumseh, you have probably heard the name Edd Barnes. He is kind of famous around these parts in the horse world. He even served on the Board of the American Quarter Horse Association. His horse of choice was the Quarter Horse and he enjoyed raising them. He was generous with his time and volunteered to be an announcer for the Pottawatomie County Fair. My daughter was in a horse show at the County Fair and Edd was the announcer. I had the privilege of visiting with him that day. He had a great announcer's voice and you could tell that it wasn't his first time. He was extra good at it. They even honored him by giving him a plaque for 50 years of continuous service. Wow, was he ever great for the County Fair. He did a whole lot of good for our community. We are thankful that he was a part of us here at Highland and we are thankful the Lord
