Hello and welcome to worship!

A very unique example the H.S. gives us in the Word of God of the Christian's life is that of a race. Anyone who has ever run a race knows there are rules. You can't cut corners. You must stay on the track. You can't have someone race for you. You must run your own race. You can't cheat. What happens if you do cheat? What happens if you cheat and take a shortcut or have someone run for you? You will be disqualified if you run this way.

Listen to **1 Corinthians 9:24-27**

"²⁴ Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one receives the prize? So run that you may obtain it. ²⁵ Every athlete exercises self-control in all things. They do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. ²⁶ So I do not run aimlessly; I do not box as one beating the air. ²⁷ But I discipline my body and keep it under control, [a] lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified." Some religious people teach you can never be disqualified from the Christian race. They teach once saved, always saved. They teach you have nothing to worry about after receiving salvation, because you can never lose it. If that teaching were true, which it is not, why would Paul speak of running his race with discipline and self-control, if there was no possibility of being disqualified? Why does Paul say there is a possibility he could be disqualified if he didn't run with discipline and self-control? He says this because there is a real possibility of being disqualified and falling away from God's grace. He knew it without a doubt and he had seen it first hand. He knew if he tried to take the easy path, the path of least resistance, the end result would not be good for him. Paul knows to stay in the race and not be disqualified and to win the prize, he must practice self-control. For any person running the Christian race, to hear the word "disqualified" would be the worst words ever. But it happens all the time. Runner after runner in the Christian race are disqualified because they don't practice self-control. Be like Paul and discipline your body and keep it under control so you can finish the race and win the prize.


