Submission. It seems to be a concept that has escaped the current culture. For the better part of a century, the world has promoted a "me-first" mentality. Instead of students accepting responsibility for their poor grades, they blame the teachers. Instead of an employee taking responsibility for their poor evaluation, they blame their supervisor. Students don't want to submit to the requirements of the class. Employees don't want to submit to the requirements of their job description. We do what we want to do. This is why the atheistic worldview is so appealing. It says that science has disproved God, and there is no need to submit to any supernatural reign; we humans are all that we have (humanism). So, because there is no God or afterlife, live the life that you want to live! Of course, this mindset is the furthest from Scripture (Ps 37:23; Prov 16:9; Jer 10:23).

Where would we be if Christ didn't submit to the will of God? Jesus knew the suffering that He was about to go through. In a prayer to God, He essentially asked for another way for the Father's will to be done (Matt 26:39). What would the "Hall of Fame of Faithfulness" look like without individuals who were willing to submit to God? Would a king be king if he didn't have subjects? Jesus is the King of our confession (1 Tim 6:12f).

Ephesians 5:18 tells us "to be filled" with the Holy Spirit. One way to be filled with the Holy Spirit is by submitting to one another. It doesn't matter what role you have in the church, we all need to have the Christian attitude that says, "How can I help?" when a brother or sister has a need. Paul uses this idea of submission as the foundation of what he will talk about from 5:22 – 6:9. Wives need to submit to their husbands because he is the head of the family. Children should submit to their parents because it is what Jesus wants. Servants submit to your master because this is the will of God. The interesting thing is that the husband, parent, and master's responsibility is also vitally important. Read the passage above to see what those responsibilities are.

On judgment day, we all will bow down and submit to Jesus. It is how we handle our role in our earthly relationships that will determine whether or not we will be looked upon with favor. Are you fulfilling your role according to God's word?
